This year we will be awarding the following scholarships in Broc's memory:

- **One - \$1,500 scholarship - to the top female senior**
- **One - \$1,500 scholarship - to the top male senior**
- **Two - \$1,250 scholarships**
- **Two - \$1,000 scholarships**

Applications must be postmarked by March 18th

Awards will be announced in **April** and recipients will be contacted by the Scholarship Committee.
